# How can you help your child's literacy development?

- Sharing books at home
- Home Reading Book – please make comments in their Home Reading Record
- Phonics – speed sound practice
- Encourage mark making, drawing, shopping lists etc
- Help children to write their name with correct letter formation
- Encourage children to talk about things they see and ask questions



# How can you help your child's mathematical development?

- Learning numbers – identifying them in everyday situations
- Writing numbers – numeral formation
- Counting at any time - climbing the stairs, in the car etc
- Playing board games
- Singing number rhymes and songs together
- Talking about shapes and patterns – encouraging children to look for these in the environment around them
