Music

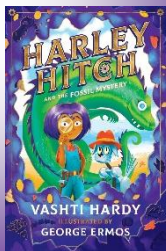
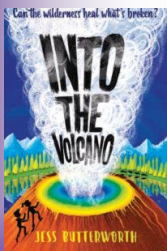
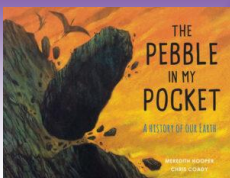
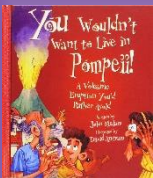
Anna Clyne *Night Ferry*. Water Compositions. Learn that rhythms can fit with words and that music can be layers of sounds.

Keeping myself safe. My healthy lifestyle.

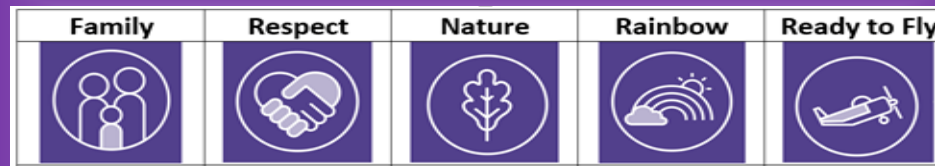

Computing

Computer systems and networks. Looking at a journey inside a computer. Looking at the different components of a computer. Data handling. Understand that you can enter simple data onto a spreadsheet. Know that computers are used to monitor supplies.

Geography

Seven continents and five oceans. Volcanoes How are volcanoes formed? Why do earthquakes happen? What is a tectonic plate? Local Fieldwork Grid references and compass directions. Find out more about our local area using fieldwork.
