Hello everybody,

It's hard to believe that the children have only just completed their first full week of the school year! They really have settled in well and are working extremely hard. They should all be really proud of that. It's also been great to see so many of the children take advantage of the wide range of **clubs** already on offer, and at the same time see some of the them try something completely new. Look out too for details of the **sporting opportunities** and team events on Dojos – there's lots coming up!

Over the next couple of weeks the children will be nominating and voting for the new **School Council** members. The School Council play such an important role in school as they really are the mouthpiece of the children. They will regular survey and gather the views and opinions of their classmates and them forward this information to myself for further discussion at staff meetings. This will be so important in helping us to shape the outdoor areas.

Now that the children are in the routine of filling their new **water bottles** at the filtered 'filling' tap, we will be sending water bottles home each night. Please support us in reminding your children to bring them in at the start of the day. They can fill them as they arrive if this is easier. I must say a huge well done to the children for remembering to regularly drink their water. Even though some found the change to drinking water tricky at first, they have tried really hard.

Over the next week we will be interviewing for a **General Teaching Assistant** to join the staff team. We have adopted a much more fluid staffing model this year in order to give us the flexibility to target our adults at children who need that bit of extra help, support or intervention in order to 'keep up', or fully understand content from morning lessons. Having an additional adult will allow us to do this even more effectively. I will update you more as soon as I can!
