## Hello everybody,

I've got to start this newsletter by saying well done to the children for the positive way in which they approached their **Spring assessments** this week. It was so good to see the children persevering when things might have been tricky, and taking on the challenge with such determination. Our Ready to Fly Pillar was clear to see in all of the classrooms.

Please let me know if you are able to come, even for a short while, to our **Garden Working Parties** next week (Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> and Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> March from 3:30pm -6pm). Our first task will probably be to remove the hedge at the front of school and further clear some of the beds. I hope that you will be able to come down and help us.

Our Ofsted inspection now feels like a lifetime ago, however we have been working hard to implement the improvements that they suggested to further enhance what we teach. We have already made several key improvements to what our children will learn, all closely linked to termly topics: **Medium term plans** for each subject now contain key questions which are central to our curriculum. Although all schools follow the National Curriculum, all are expected to adapt it to meet local needs. Ours is shaped by our Pillars and also by the need to broaden the children's knowledge of diversity, as well as expose them to global opportunities and issues. This is all designed to prepare them as well as possible for life in the modern world. I'll share these with you at the upcoming parents' evenings.

It is also important for us to know what the children already know, before we start teaching the different areas. We have recently enhanced our **Pre and Post- Assessments** to include the key questions outlined in the plans above. These also include a focus on vocabulary. As the Pre-assessments are completed before a topic starts, teachers will change the content of their teaching in response to these. The Post-assessments are completed at the end of topics give us a clear indication of what the children have learnt. Again, I will share these with you at parents' evening.

Huge thanks to **Friends** for their ongoing tireless support. You may have seen that they are currently investigating how we might access/fund a minibus, so that classes, clubs and sports teams can more easily access learning outside the classroom, such as accessing alternative Forest School venues. More details of this will be also be shared at the parents' evening.










# This week's attendance
