**Hello everybody,**

As you already know, *Respect* is one of our **School Pillars**. We have been reviewing and updating our **behaviour policy** over the course of the last term and it has been really interesting to unpick what this actually means (given that respect is not a quantifiable thing in itself) with the staff and the children. As a collective we came up with the following indicators of the children showing Respect to others, all of which we will be actively noticing and celebrating as the year goes on:

- show good manners: 'please' and 'thank you'
- hold doors open for others
- offer to help / ask if others need help
- not laugh if somebody drops something
- walk sensibly
- clear up own mess at lunchtime
- don't interrupt
- line up silently and sensibly
- use 'excuse me'
- leave things tidy and put things away properly
- spot things that need doing and take the right action
- look after equipment

As with all of the school Pillars, this will hopefully give the children a scaffold and something to draw back upon when they get older.

I'm delighted to formally announce that Rob Longworth has been elected as **Parent Governor** to the Governing Body following the recent Parent Governor election process. The governors and I know that Rob will bring so much to the Governing Body and look forward greatly to working with him.

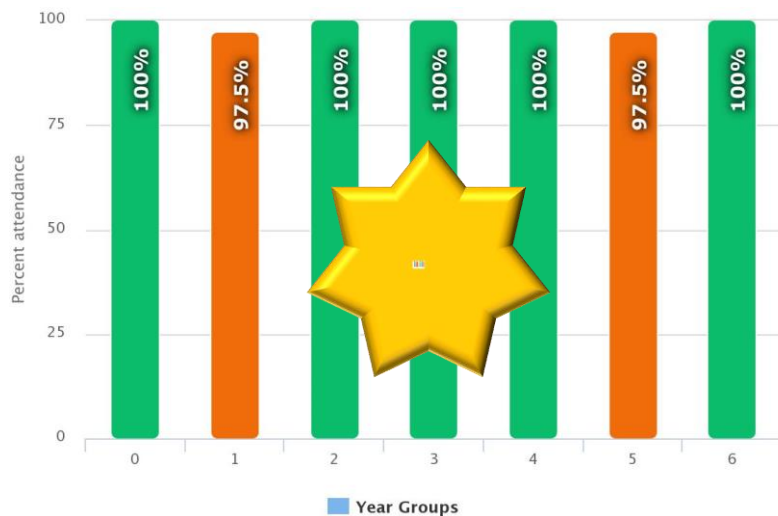
