Year 6 SATs

Huge well done to the Year 6 pupils for tackling their SATs with such determination, perseverance and calmness. We are all really proud of you all. We enter a quite bizarre period of time now as the completed tests were packed, sealed and dispatched the same day to some far-distant, mysterious land to be marked. We won't get the results until Tuesday 11th July!

Year 2 SATs

Next week the Year 2 pupils will also be tackling their Key Stage 1 SATs. These are slightly different to the Key Stage 2 SATs as they are marked in school and are used by the teachers to assess the children against the end of Key stage 1 expectations. The children have been working extremely hard lately to improve their scores and I look forward to them also demonstrating perseverance, bravery and determination when tackling them. As always, we will approach these positively and make them as stress-free and enjoyable as possible.

Grounds developments

You may have noticed that (largely through the efforts of the Gardening Club and Mr Longworth!) the front garden is really taking shape now. Huge thanks to them for what they have achieved for the school. Developments will continue at pace however – we are already looking to develop vegetable plots at the side of school so that the children can experience the full cycle of planting, nurturing, harvesting and eating (and composting!) the fruit and vegetables. With **Nature** being one of our core **Pillars**, teaching the children how to live in a sustainable way that impacts as little as possible on the environment is so important to us. This has been brought into even clearer focus given the seemingly ever-increasing cost of consumables. This is continuing to impact hugely on the school budget and so becoming ever more sustainable and conscious of this can only help.

Sportsdesk

The **Year 3 and 4 Cricket team** will be taking part in the *Summer Smash* tournament at North Marine Road next Thursday. I look forward to seeing them represent the school their first matches! Results don't really matter at these events as long as the children enjoy them. They are fabulous for building confidence, communication skills and a sense of belonging, all of which help the children as they get older.

Continuing the sporting theme, next Thursday all of the children will be enjoying **Skateboarding** (yes – skateboarding!) activities in school! We're always looking to give the children different experiences and this looked too good an opportunity and too exciting to miss! Don't worry – those leading the sessions are trained skateboarding coaches. Knee pads, elbow pads and helmets will all be provided if needed, as will the skateboards themselves. If you see me veering towards the hill outside school please act accordingly!

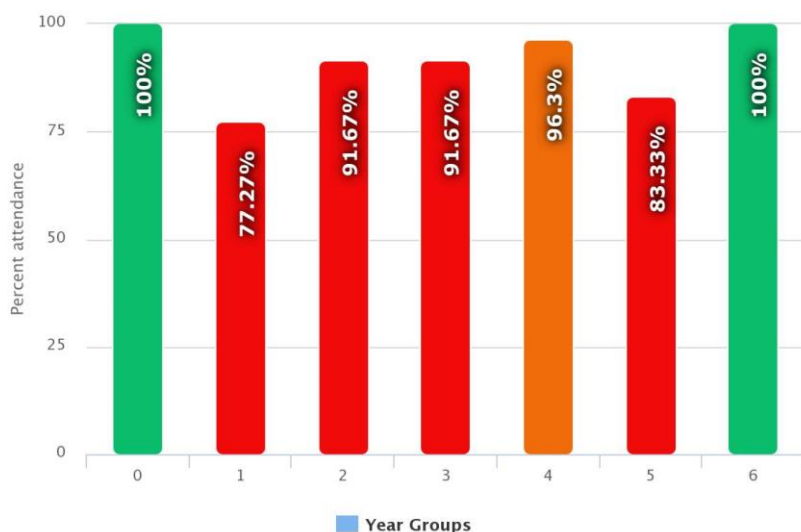
