Next week the Year 3 and 4 children will be enjoying the activities at East Barnby. Residential are also central to our Nature Pillar, giving the children opportunities to learn and be outdoors, especially with the huge positive impact this can have on mental health. - **Is likely to suffer significant harm and/or;**
- **Has developmental and welfare needs which are likely only to be met through provision of family support services (with agreement of the child's parent)**

Luisa King, Ataiya from Class 2's, mum, is embarking on a huge challenge at the weekend. She is taking part in the National 3 Peaks Challenge, which consists of the following peaks:

Ben Nevis, in Scotland (1345m)
Scafell Pike, in England (978m)
Snowdon, in Wales (1085m)

This is a total walking distance of 23 miles and the total ascent is 3064 metres (10,052ft) - twice the ascent of the Yorkshire Three Peaks and a total driving distance is 462 miles.

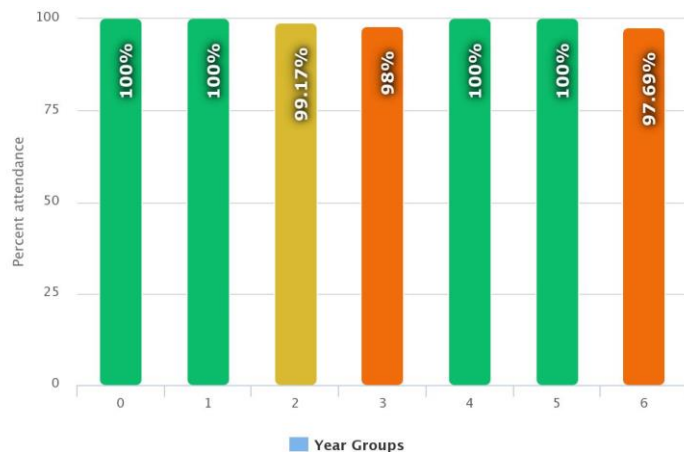
