Hello Everybody,

This week we have an unashamedly sports-based newsletter! I've got to first say a huge well done to the Year 3/4 girls who represented the school so well at the **North Yorkshire Cricket Championships** earlier this week. They won 2 out of 5 matches, losing two others by just 1 and 7 runs! Considering that we were playing some of the best sides in the County, to finish joint third is a magnificent achievement and one which they should be really proud of. It's even more remarkable given that most of the team only started playing the game 4 weeks ago! *We might be a small school but we have big hearts and big aspirations – given the chance, our children can flourish.* This follows hot on the heels of a great performance by the boys at their local tournament last week at Flixton.



Giving the children the opportunities to take part in such events and other sporting activities is so important to us. It has been great to see the children collaborating so well, facing challenges, solving problems, communicating and persevering – all within the sports that they have been playing. This week has also brought home just how important these opportunities are in developing the children's confidence. All of these will ultimately have a positive impact on learning and be skills and experiences that the children can draw upon in later life. Lessons missed to attend additional practices or events aren't lost – the children learn so much on the pitch/court beyond the sport that they are playing. Although the last couple of weeks have been cricket based, we'll continue to try to give the children as many different opportunities as we can in the future. Next week the Year 5/6 Girls will also be representing the Scarborough area at the County Cricket Finals!

Next week we will be welcoming the new Reception children into our school family. The children and staff can't wait to meet the new children and their families. I know that the children in Class 1 will do everything they can to make them feel as welcome as possible! This week we have seen them participate in a

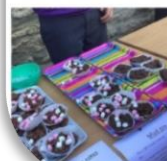

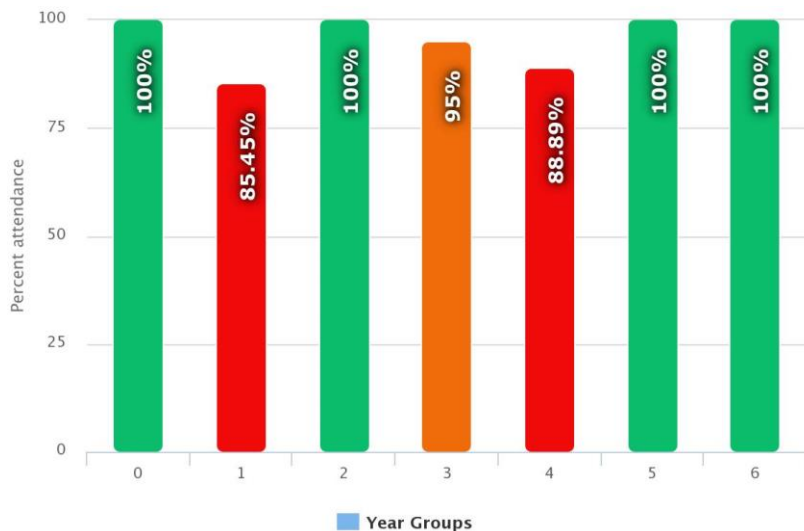
