- Has developmental and welfare needs which are likely only to be met through provision of family support services (with agreement of the child's parent)

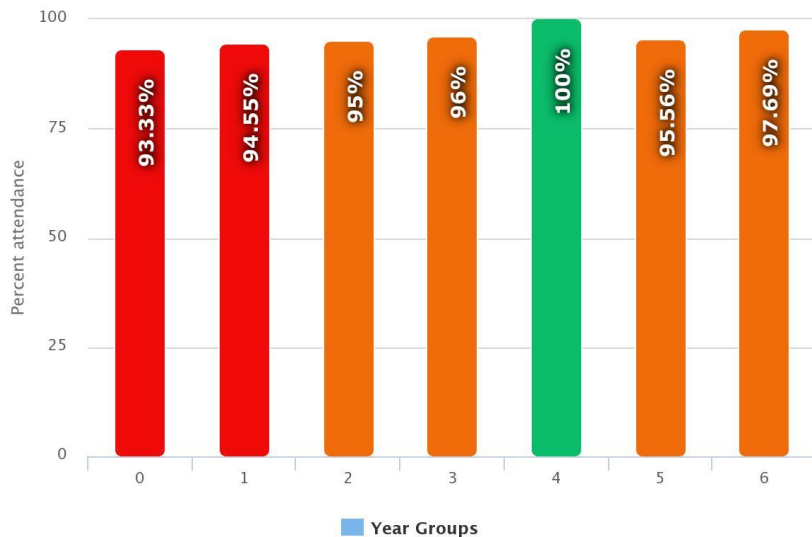
