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Hello everybody,
It's an exciting week next week!

ANNUAL BUDGETING HELP 2023/2024

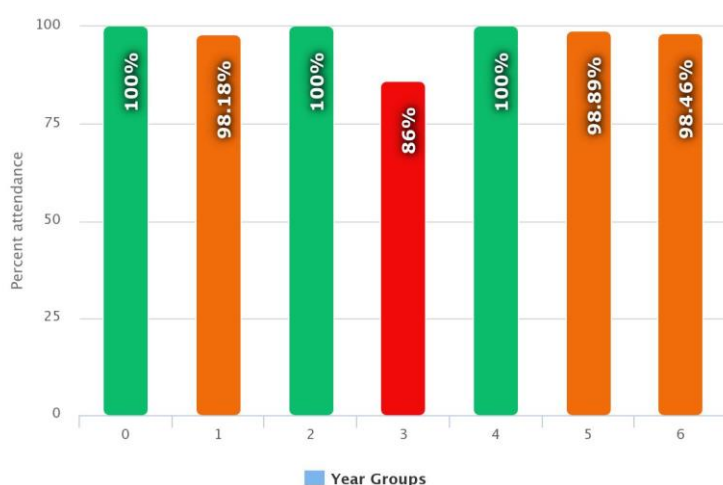
