I am so, so proud of the children for starting the new term with such enthusiasm and determination. They have really 'hit the ground running' this week and the new topics have started at pace.

On Monday the staff had a training day based around further refining how we teach maths through the school. This also marked the introduction of a new, short daily 'fluency' session for the children, aimed at improving the speed at which they can recall key facts, bonds and multiplication tables throughout the school. Children in Years 3 to 6 will have some flashcards to help them practice these at home too.

Beyond the new topics in each class, there is a lot to look forward to this term- from trips, to new outdoor learning areas to the launch of our new 'Forest' school. The sporting fixtures will soon be restarting too! Read With Me sessions will also be continuing from next week and we will soon have another Stay And Learn session to show you how we teach our maths.

The counselling sessions will also be starting next week for the first group of children. There is still time to put your child's name forward if you would like them to receive this support. We will require signed consent forms before any sessions can start.
