#### Hi everybody,

It's been another busy and exciting week for the children. On Monday Class 1 celebrated Earth Day, a chance to reflect on what we can do to protect the environment at a local and global level. I know that the children really enjoyed making their seed bombs and I look forward to hearing about how well they have grown!

On Tuesday the children got the chance to experience Science Bus – a whole range of exciting experiments designed to enthuse and excite the children. Activities like these are important to us in broadening subjects beyond the classroom and making the children realise that science is all around us.

As a Local Authority School, we work closely with School Improvement Advisors. Or allocated advisor, Stuart Anslow, visited us on Monday to look at how our improved curriculum will further develop the children's Global Knowledge, understanding of Diversity and Aspirations. 




## The government expectation for all schools is 96%+ attendance.
