Hi everybody,

Thanks for all of your support and attendance at the *Read With Me* and *Stay and Learn Sessions* this week – it has been much appreciated by all of the staff. All of the latest research recognises that the constant recapping and retrieval of information is key to the children remembering more, which is why we start our sessions in this way. Whenever you are in school, we would really appreciate it if you could please refrain from using **mobile phones**. Even though we know you all well, this is part of our safeguarding policy.

Although undoubtedly hoping to be part of Wild School, we currently have quite a few **nits** in school. Please check your child/ren for us and treat if needed! Collecting wildlife about one's person will not be one of the challenges on the children's Wild School passports!

Attendance

Although our attendance for the year is still better than the regional and national average, it has dipped significantly since February. Please do everything you can to ensure that your child attends as well as possible. Sessions missed can have a huge impact. If we can help in any way at all with this, please let me know.

Safeguarding

You may have seen our latest **Online Safety** poster which I shared on Dojos earlier in the week. Ofsted have recently raised their expectations regarding what filtering and monitoring systems schools have in place to protect the children. Our systems are overseen by Smoothwall – meaning that, should anybody try to access a website that might expose them to inappropriate content, this is flagged immediately. This system also continuously filters what online content can be accessed. Should you have any questions regarding the poster, or if we can help in any way at all, please let me know.

This week's attendance

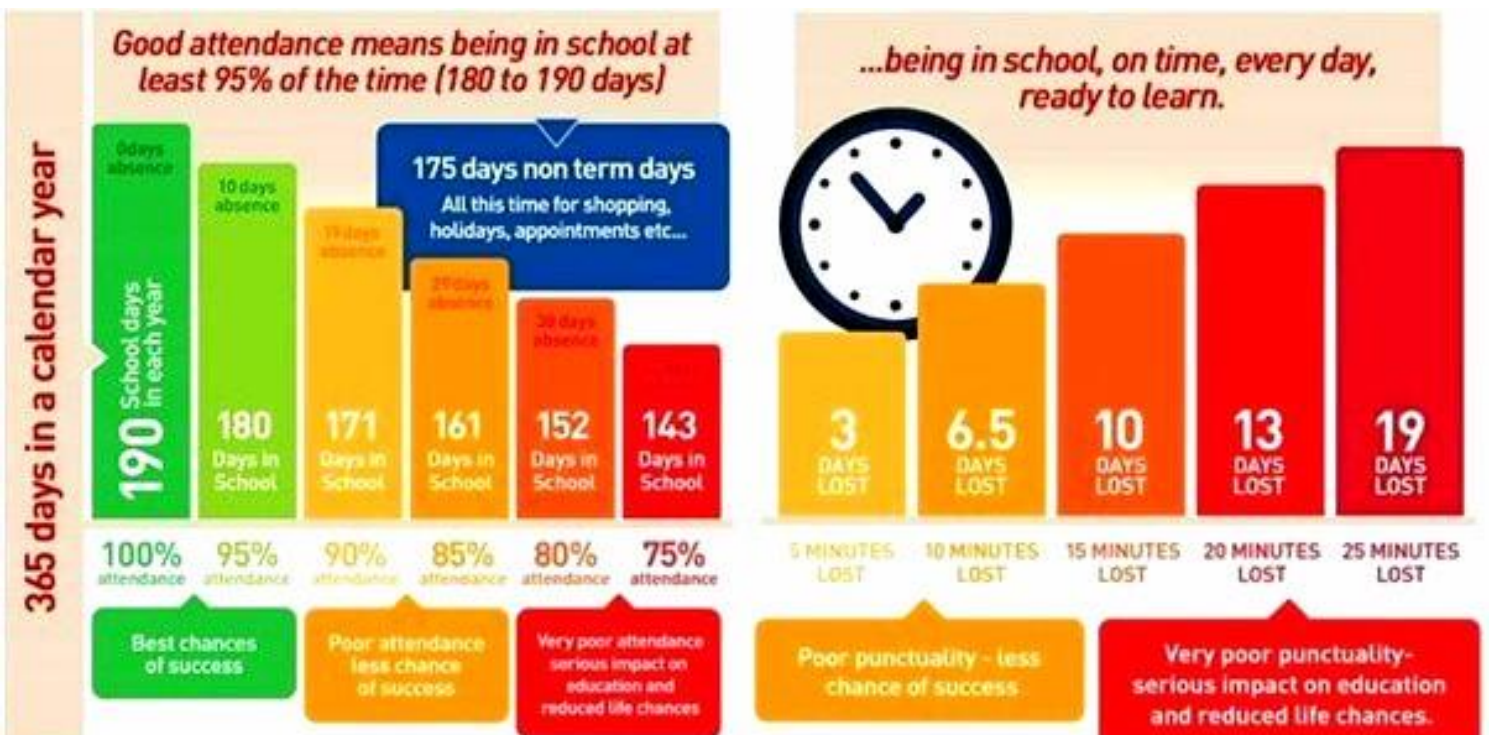


The government expectation for all schools is **96%+** attendance.
