Dear Parents and Carers,

Educational Visit to Eureka – Wednesday 28 February 2018

Class 3 have the wonderful opportunity to visit Eureka! Children's Museum. This will act as an excellent provocation to our science and PSHE learning next half-term. Children will be able to have exclusive access to Eureka's 'SoundSpace' and 'SoundGarden' to help support our new science focus of Sound. The class will also be able to investigate other interactive and play-based galleries, such as 'All About Me' and 'Living and Working Together'; galleries which allow the children to work in teams and take on roles such as doctor, bank manager, mechanic, sales assistant, and much more! The children will also have the exciting opportunity to take part in a programming workshop, controlling a simple device called 'Raspberry Pi'.

The museum is located in Halifax, therefore we need to **depart school, by coach, at 8.15am**. We therefore request that children **arrive at school at 8am** to accommodate for this. As we aim to make the most of all the galleries, we envisage that we should arrive **back at school at 4.30pm** (traffic permitting).

Children will need to wear normal school uniform for the visit. Children will also be required to bring a named packed lunch and a named drinks bottle. These items should be kept in a small rucksack or a plastic bag, as storage is limited. If you would like your child to receive a lunch prepared by school, then please type in the notes box, your child's choice of sandwich filling (cheese/tuna/egg) or typing "Home" if you will provide a lunch from home.

The total cost of the trip **would be £27.63**. However, the Friends of Brompton School have once again kindly subsidised the cost of the transport for the trip. We therefore ask parents for a voluntary contribution of **£15 per child** to cover the rest of the transport cost and the entrance fee. Sadly, if we do not receive enough contributions the trip will not go ahead.
