ParentPay accounts should carry a zero balance or be in credit for all items. Please ensure that milk is paid at the very start of each term and that meals are paid for in advance by the Monday of the week in which they are required. Several families who currently have an outstanding balance and this is time consuming to administrate and causes problems in balancing the monthly accounts.

You can receive:

- an alert when your child's balance runs low
- and an alert when you have something new to pay for.

Here's how to set-up Alerts:

Simply go to Profile > Alert settings >

Select the type of Alert (low balance and/or new item) and then select how you want to receive alerts, email and/or SMS Text.

Email alerts are free of charge. If you opt for SMS text alerts there is a small charge per text.

There is a County procedure we must follow for arrears and letters will now be posted home where there is money owing.

It provides an opportunity for you to see and/or update the information we hold and will also include an application for free school meals based on income and receipt of certain benefits. Forest Schools starts again this term for Classes 1 and 2 on alternate Thursdays. Children will need wellies, waterproof trousers, waterproof jacket and jogging bottoms with them. Look out for the consent letter coming home to all new starters, with more details. Unfortunately we cannot take children to Forest Schools if they do not have full waterproofs with them so please check the newsletter for dates. PE will take place on the intervening weeks.
