Please read all of the information on the admissions and transport pages before completing an application form.

For online applications you need to create an account, verify it and then log back in to add your child, your school preferences and your details. You can then review it and submit your application. You will then receive an e-mail acknowledgement.

You must submit an application form no later than 15 January 2018. Late applications will be dealt with later than those received online and this could affect the allocation of your child's school place.

You will be notified by e-mail on National Offer Day which is 16 April 2018.

Letters have been sent home with full details if you have a sibling already in School.
