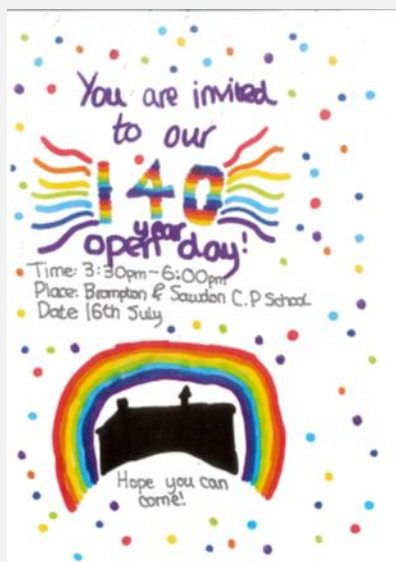

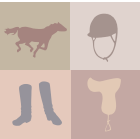
All items to be brought to school by Wednesday 18 July**

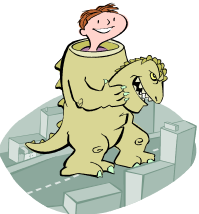

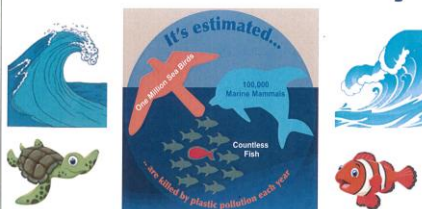
