Dear Families and Friends,


Having finished last week at the archaeological dig in the village, it is great to report back that one of my many meetings this week has been about gaining a Heritage School award with Historic England.

Applying for a Primary School place for your child for September 2019

For families who live in North Yorkshire, if you have a child who was born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015 you will need to apply for a primary school place for them to start in Reception in September 2019. The deadline for applications is 15 January 2019.

Families living outside North Yorkshire will need to contact their home authority to obtain the information regarding school admissions.
