Dear Families and Friends,

I hope you have managed to see the exciting news that our very own Miss Watts is due to have a baby in February. Please can I reiterate that all staffing arrangements will be communicated with parents/carers as soon as they are finalised. We know uncertainty can be uncomfortable, so do bear with us whilst we make these important decisions.

Can I also reiterate the importance of not sending your children to school should they be displaying symptoms of infectious illnesses (especially chicken pox). Students with chicken pox should be kept at home until all spots have scabbed over (typically 5 days after they first appear). Thank you for your understanding.

This week saw the whole school begin their Forest School sessions. We will endeavour (weather-permitting) to get the whole school to go to the forest every Wednesday, to take part in outdoor activities, such as fire-lighting and bushcraft. Please make sure your child has their Forest School kit with them every Wednesday.
