Dear Families and Friends,

Welcome back to school. I hope you all enjoyed the half-term break and children feel reenergised for the new (and, yet again, busy) half-term. Already, students in Class 1 & 2 are preparing for their end of term nativity by practising songs and learning their lines. They are also not letting this be a distraction to their school work in lessons, which is a fantastic attitude.

Road Safety

Once again, please can I stress how important it is that we are especially vigilant around the roads at all school entrances. We recognise that the 'sweeping' bend around the side of the school is not ideal; it is a blind corner without a footpath.

Drivers and pedestrians on equal measure should be vigilant around this location, especially as we have younger students that are still developing their road awareness.

Recently, we have taken steps to improve road safety in school, including developing a new taxi routine. We have, in the past, also advised that parents/carers that they can use The Forge car park free of charge at pick-up and drop-off times, to avoid congestion around school and limit the amount of vehicles. This is still available.

Can I now also advise that parents/carers, where possible, avoid driving around the corner of the school at pick-up and drop-off times by parking and leaving on the same route. For example, parking at the front of school and leaving via Cayley Lane, rather than driving around the school where children are still waiting. Similarly, if parking close to the A170 and Cayley Arms, leaving towards this direction too, rather than driving around the side of the school.

The school is taking steps to discuss other possibilities for this piece of road with Highways and Parish Councillors. Please do get in touch if you would like to know more about how you can help the school with road safety. We hope to provide an even safer site for your children.

Finally, can I remind you, as I have on Class Dojo, that next Friday is Children in Need Spotty Day – children may come to school in spotty clothing with a suggested donation of £1 for doing so.
