Dear Families and Friends,

Thank you to all who attended our **Parents'/Carers' Evening** on Monday and Wednesday. The feedback we received from you all was really positive and, I believe, a strong reflection on how far the school has come over the two terms – we hope to continue this trend. Please can you return any outstanding questionnaires (and any other documentation provided by Mrs Hargreaves) as soon as possible.

I have some **exciting news** (for those of you that have not heard through your children): I am pleased to announce that Mrs Sadler is pregnant! Of course, this means that we now have two members of staff pregnant in the school, so can I reiterate the importance of keeping children with infectious illnesses (e.g. Chicken Pox) at home and away from school until they are no longer infectious. For example, a child with Chicken Pox should stay at home until all spots have crusted over (typically 5-6 days after spots appear). Should a child display symptoms of chicken pox whilst at school, parents/carers will be contacted immediately to collect their child. Thank you for your understanding.

I will, in the next couple of weeks, provide an update to future **staffing arrangements** in school (within a separate letter). This will include information regarding: the headteacher, maternity cover in Class 1 and teaching arrangements throughout the school. Please be reassured that all future plans will take full regard for all our students' progress and happiness and will limit disruption wherever possible.

Finally, can I thank you all for your generosity (and creativity) during our **'Spotty Day'** in aid of Children in Need. I enjoy seeing the efforts children (and parents/carers) go to on our charity 'dressing-up' days, although I know that the children understand the important reasons for having these days and that the money we raise goes to important causes. It also raises the awareness of how lucky our children are to be able to enjoy these days, when many in the country and World cannot.
