Dear Families and Friends,

We are coming to the end of a very busy but productive half-term. It has been a pleasure to see how all students have progressed and grown up over the last 6 weeks, especially those children new to the school. Next week, the hard work continues, although we do have some fun/relaxing activities, especially on the final day of the half-term. As you will have seen on Class Dojo, we are having a dress-up/Halloween day on Friday, to mark Miss Draper's final day in our school and to also allow students who celebrate Halloween an opportunity to do so, as, with COVID restrictions, things like 'Trick-or-Treating' or Halloween parties may be very difficult to achieve this year.

The society along with conducting research and raising awareness provide invaluable support to people and their families who have been affected by the many forms of encephalitis. We have raised funds for them before by running Loch Ness marathon and it was my hope to complete a nonstop 100k ultra marathon this year for them but this is now postponed till summer 2021.



The Stroud Family: SALT is a small local charity which started 8 years ago in a rundown empty shop with a few items from family and friends to sell. The idea was to give relief to people in need because of age, ill health, disability or financial hardship. To date the charity has give over £240,000 to the local community.

Every year SALT gives £5,000 in food vouchers at Christmas but the main funding is given to individuals for white goods, beds, carpets, school uniforms furniture, laptops etc.

Before the present crisis the charity gave priority to young people, helping Scouts, Guides, Cubs and Brownie groups. It also supports schools (this is how we got our school greenhouse!) and other charities as well as the local hospital and numerous other projects throughout the local community.

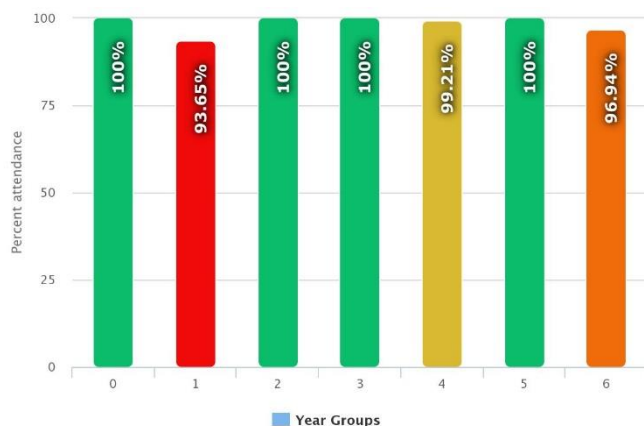
