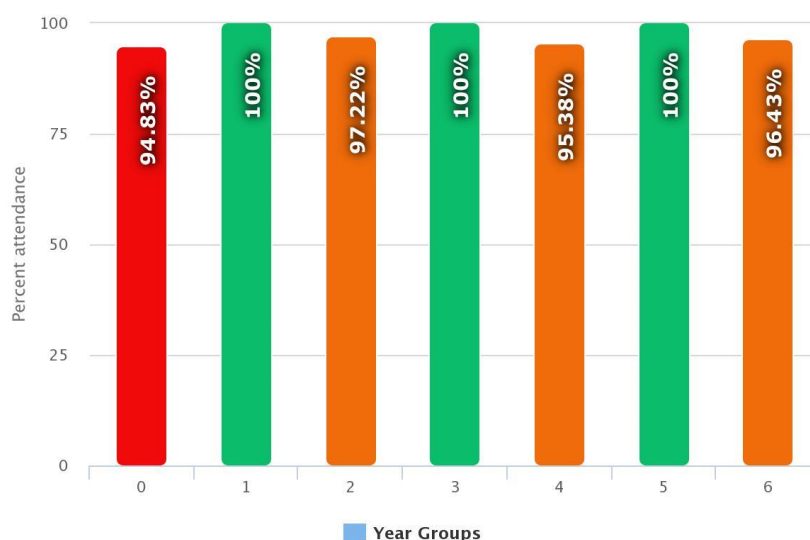
## The Brompton Family
