Dear Families and Friends,

What a contrast in weather we have had this week! The rain has not dampened our spirits in and out of school – I have enjoying seeing lots of great work and fun activities taking place through Class Dojo.

Three Hub System

As you may be aware, next week, we are moving to a three 'hub' system. This means that we will have three isolated 'bubbles' of children working in school with their teacher. These hubs will work, play and eat together in their respective classrooms.

We are really pleased to see so many students come back before the end of term, so they can either sign off their time with us or prepare for the new school year by, possibly, working with their new class teacher. I believe it will be a big reassurance to children who are moving classes to have the next two weeks in their new classroom, getting used to new routines and a new teacher, rather than leaving it until September, when it would be an even bigger 'shock to the system'.

For those attending school over the final two weeks of term, a hub letter has been sent out to you via e-mail for your child's respective hub. It is especially important that you follow the guidance on this letter, so that we can ensure the safety of all school users. In particular, please may I draw your attention to the sections related to drop-off/collection times and locations, which must be strictly adhered to. Thank you for your understanding.

We still have a small number of places available in some of the hubs, so please contact us as soon as possible, if you would like your child to attend (even if it is just for a day or two). We will endeavour to place students with their friends and/or their new/current teacher, however, this will be subject to demand.

Leavers' Assembly – Tuesday 14th July – 2pm (via Zoom)

I am delighted to announce that we will be able to hold a Leavers' Assembly on Tuesday 14th July via video conferencing app, Zoom. Details of this event have already been posted onto Class Dojo, with a private link and password available for all Brompton families, as well as extended family and friends of the Year 6s.

If you are thinking of joining us, please let the school know, roughly, how many people will be watching, so we can plan accordingly. Students already in school will be watching on their big screen in their own bubbles and will even take part!

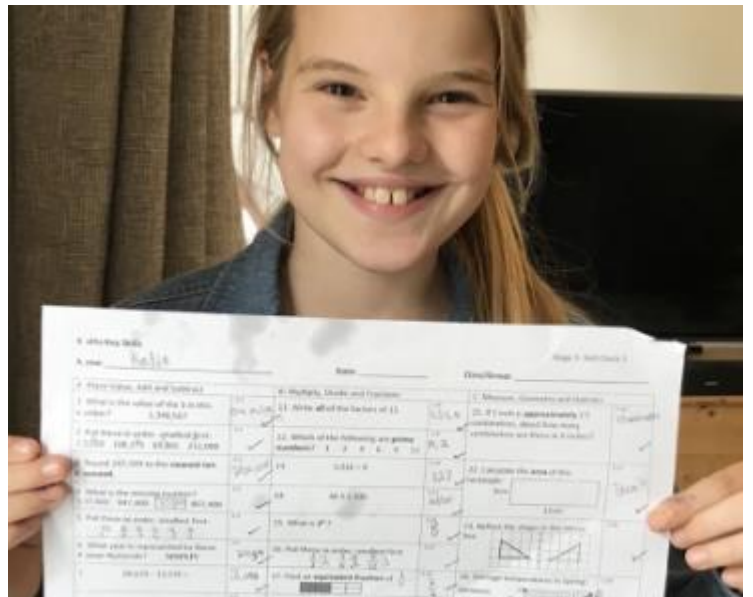
We hope to include as many of the traditional sections of the assembly as possible, albeit with added technical and social distancing accommodations. We hope to see you there!

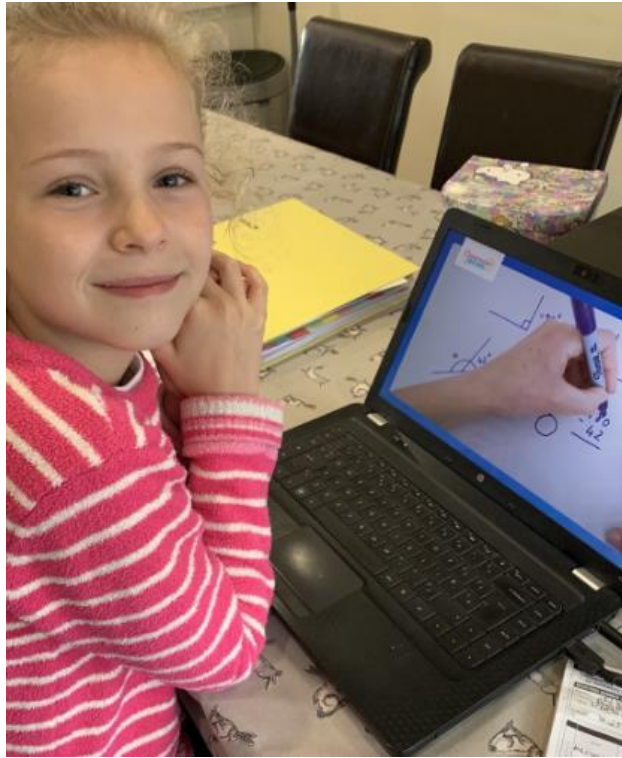
